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Report on review of interim consolidated financial information

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#### REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL INFORMATION

#### Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying interim condensed consolidated balance sheet of Sokouk Holding Company - K.S.C. (Holding) (the parent company) and subsidiaries (the group) as of September 30, 2007 and the related interim condensed consolidated statements of income, changes in equity and cash flows for the Ninemonths period then ended. Management is responsible for the preparation and presentation of these interim consolidated financial information in accordance with International Accounting Standard 34, 'Interim Financial Reporting'. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on these interim consolidated financial information based on our review.

#### Scope of Review

We conducted our review in accordance with International Standard on Review Engagements 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity." A review of interim consolidated financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with International Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

#### Conclusion

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying interim consolidated financial information is not prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with International Accounting Standard 34.

#### Report on other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

Furthermore, the interim consolidated financial information is in agreement with the Parent Company books of account and to the best of our knowledge and belief, there were no contraventions during the period ended September 30, 2007 of either the Commercial Companies Law or the Parent Company's Articles of Association, which might have materially affected the Group's financial position or results of its operations.

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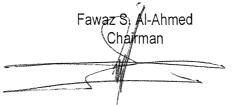

#### 1. Incorporation and activities

Sokouk Holding Company – K.S.C. (Holding) "the parent company", (previously known as Sokouk Real Estate Development Company – K.S.C. (Closed) and prior before as Al-Wasta Real Estate Development Company – K.S.C. (Closed)), is registered in the State of Kuwait and was incorporated and authenticated at the Ministry of Justice – Real Estate Registration and Authentication Department under Ref. No. 1909/Volume 1 on August 23, 1998 and registered on commercial register under Ref. No. 74323 dated August 29, 1998.

The parent company's registered address is P.O. Box 29110 Safat – Postal code 13152 - State of Kuwait.

The interim consolidated financial information were authorized for issue by the Board of Directors on November 13, 2007.

#### 2. Basis of preparation

These interim consolidated financial information have been prepared in accordance with the same accounting policies and methods of computation as were followed in the most recent consolidated annual financial statement.

The interim consolidated financial information have been prepared to present consolidated financial information in compliance with the International Accounting Standard No. 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" and the guidelines issued by the Kuwait Stock Exchange. Interim consolidated financial information does not include all of the information and footnotes required for complete financial statements prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards. In the opinion of management, all adjustments consisting of normal recurring accruals considered necessary for a fair presentation have been included in the accompanying interim consolidated financial information. Operating results for the interim period ended September 30, 2007 are not necessarily indicative of the results that may be expected for the year ending December 31, 2007. For further information, refer to the consolidated financial statement and notes thereto for the year ended December 31, 2006.

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#### 10. Murabaha payable

During the period, the Group entered into new Murabaha payable contracts carrying an annual charge varying from 5% to 9%.

#### 11. Capital

Authorized, issued and fully paid-up capital consist of 300,000,000 shares of 100 fils each (2005 - 300,000,000 shares of 100 fils each).

Subsequent to the interim consolidated financial information date, the ordinary shareholders' General Assembly held on September 30, 2007 and the extra ordinary shareholders' General Assembly held on October 22, 2007 approved to increase capital from KD 30,000,000 to KD 100,000,000. The parent company is in the process of finalizing the legal matters.
